Harbor launch, heartland middle, Central Florida crossroads, river-town recovery, and Jacksonville handoff.

Set the entry decision, driving rhythm, anchor order, backup stops, route distinctions, and exit decision for this canonical Route 17 chapter.

Entry decision and driving rhythm

Punta Gorda: decide whether the route begins softly on the harbor edge or moves quickly inland.

Rhythm to protect

- [] Punta Gorda -> Peace River / heartland -> Central Florida crossroads -> St. Johns River towns -> Jacksonville.
- [] Use Arcadia as the clean inland reset.
- [] Allow extra pacing margin through Winter Haven, Lake Alfred, Haines City, Kissimmee, and Orlando.
- [] Sanford, DeLand, Palatka, and Green Cove Springs restore a calmer river-town rhythm before Jacksonville.

LAUNCH Punta Gorda Harbor-first start.	RESET Arcadia Old-Florida / heartland pause.
HANDOFF Jacksonville City-scale gateway before Georgia.	

DRIVING CHAPTER

Backup anchors and route distinctions

Keep backups useful and selective; do not turn the segment into a stop-everywhere checklist.

Backup / support choices

[] Zolfo Springs, Wauchula, Fort Meade, and Bartow keep the heartland sequence legible.

[] At Zolfo Springs, Florida SR 66 is an optional eastbound choice; stay on U.S. 17 for the northbound Route 17 sequence.

[] Orange Park and Yulee support the Jacksonville transition.

Exit / next-chapter decision

Northbound, leave Jacksonville ready for the coastal Georgia chapter. Southbound, let Punta Gorda soften the finish.
