How Florida works on Route 17

Southern launch chapter: harbor start, inland reset, Central Florida crossroads, St. Johns River recovery, and Jacksonville gateway.

SOUTHERN START Punta Gorda Harbor-first launch and a gentler opening pace.	INLAND RESET Arcadia Old-Florida / Peace River pause that keeps the middle honest.
NORTHERN GATEWAY Jacksonville Major city-scale reset before the Georgia coast approach.	

Driving zones

1	Punta Gorda and southern harbor start	Decide whether the route begins softly on the waterfront or moves quickly inland.
2	Peace River and heartland middle	Arcadia plus Zolfo Springs, Wauchula, Fort Meade, and Bartow give the opening an interior Florida rhythm.
3	Central Florida crossroads	Winter Haven, Lake Alfred, Haines City, Kissimmee, and Orlando are pacing-heavy route-choice territory.
4	St. Johns River approach	Sanford, DeLand, Palatka, and Green Cove Springs restore river-town and historic-downtown rhythm.
5	Jacksonville and state-line handoff	Jacksonville closes the Florida chapter; Orange Park and Yulee support the transition rather than replace the anchor.

DECISION SHEET

Anchors, backups, and route decisions

Use the state page as a chapter map, not as a checklist of every town.

Useful support stops

- [] Zolfo Springs - route-choice cue where Florida SR 66 heads east; stay on U.S. 17 for the northbound Route 17 sequence.
- [] Wauchula / Fort Meade / Bartow - heartland continuity, not three required stops.
- [] Central Florida cities - treat as pacing and route-choice pressure, not a mandatory checklist.
- [] Sanford / DeLand / Palatka / Green Cove Springs - river and historic-town recovery before Jacksonville.
- [] Orange Park / Yulee - transition support around the Jacksonville gateway.

Decisions to make before the day

- [] Choose whether Punta Gorda is a true start/overnight or simply the launch point.
- [] Give Arcadia one clear reset role instead of making the middle a second destination.
- [] Allow extra margin through Central Florida; route choice matters more here than scenery alone.
- [] Protect Jacksonville arrival time if the next day continues to coastal Georgia.
