How Georgia works on Route 17

Compact coastal gateway: Florida line, Golden Isles / Brunswick reset, then Savannah as the historic-city payoff and Lowcountry handoff.

SOUTHERN LAUNCH Jacksonville Major Florida gateway that sets up the Georgia coast.	PRACTICAL MIDDLE Brunswick The clearest coastal reset and Golden Isles middle.
HISTORIC ANCHOR Savannah Georgia finish, overnight, or launch toward Charleston.	

Driving zones

1	Florida line and gateway choice	Move from Jacksonville scale into quieter coastal Georgia logic.
2	Golden Isles middle	Use Brunswick as the one practical middle rather than stacking many small stops.
3	Historic-city payoff	Savannah resolves the Georgia chapter and can become the hinge toward Charleston.

DECISION SHEET

Anchors, backups, and route decisions

Use the state page as a chapter map, not as a checklist of every town.

Useful support stops

- ☐ Kingsland - quick state-line downtown reset.
- ☐ Woodbine - short Satilla River pause.
- ☐ Darien - waterfront support between Brunswick and Savannah.
- ☐ Midway - focused Highway 17 history stop.
- ☐ Port Wentworth - Savannah-area services/support; current U.S. 17 does not run through the city center.

Decisions to make before the day

- ☐ Decide if Georgia is a fast connector, a one-reset coast day, or a fuller coastal chapter.
- ☐ Keep Brunswick as the middle reset; do not make it compete with Savannah for city-scale time.
- ☐ Arrive in Savannah with enough margin for the city to feel like the payoff.
- ☐ If continuing north, treat Savannah as the clean handoff into the South Carolina Lowcountry.

Current-condition checks

Planning aid only - verify current weather, construction, closures, operating hours, lodging, fuel, parking, and access before driving.

Cut-first rule

If the day runs long, cut optional support stops before cutting the primary anchor or the safe arrival margin.
