USE THIS FOR

Set the entry decision, driving rhythm, anchor order, backup stops, route distinctions, and exit decision for this canonical Route 17 chapter.

Entry decision and driving rhythm

Wilmington: decide whether the Cape Fear city is the overnight/anchor or the launch into the North Carolina chapter.

Rhythm to protect

- [] Wilmington -> New Bern -> Edenton -> Elizabeth City.
- [] New Bern is the first clear reset.
- [] Edenton is the slower waterfront-history middle.
- [] Elizabeth City is the northern cue before Virginia.

CITY ARRIVAL Wilmington Cape Fear anchor.	RIVER RESET New Bern Measured middle pause.
SLOW HISTORY Edenton Quiet waterfront stop.	HANDOFF Elizabeth City Virginia setup.

DRIVING CHAPTER

Backup anchors and route distinctions

Keep backups useful and selective; do not turn the segment into a stop-everywhere checklist.

Backup / support choices

- [] Leland - Wilmington-side logistics.
- [] Jacksonville, NC - full-service Onslow reset.
- [] Washington / Williamston / Windsor - river progression through the middle.
- [] Hertford / Camden / South Mills - Albemarle and Dismal Swamp approach.

Exit / next-chapter decision

Northbound, leave Elizabeth City with the Virginia gateway in view. Southbound, use the same anchors to rebuild the quieter North Carolina sequence.
