Before signal gets weak

This is not an emergency-services directory. It is a memory aid for the route decisions you already verified.

- [] Download / save your preferred map area.
- [] Write the exact start and finish for the day.
- [] Write the primary anchor and one backup reset.
- [] Record any lodging or time-sensitive reservation details you already verified.
- [] Note the state / segment you expect to enter next.
- [] Write the route distinction that matters (junction, branch, state line, or city handoff).
- [] Carry water / charging appropriate to your own travel needs.

Do not rely on this sheet for live status

Construction, closures, weather, hours, fuel availability, and access can change. Confirm them from current sources whenever you have connectivity.
